This Privacy Policy governs your use of www.travistravis.co, www.travistrav.is and related subdomains, operated by Travis Travis Pty Ltd. Throughout the site, the terms “we”, “us” and “our” refer to Travis Travis Pty Ltd. Travis Travis Pty Ltd offers this website, including all information, tools and services available from this site to you, the user, conditioned upon your acceptance of all terms, conditions, policies and notices stated here.

- Our Privacy Policy explains how we work with collect, use, share and protect information in relation to our web site (collectively, the "**Service**"), and your choices about the collection and use of your information.

1. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We collect the following types of information.

Information you provide us directly:

- Your username, password and e-mail address when you register for an account.
- Profile information that you provide for your user profile
- User Content (e.g. photos, comments, and other materials) that you post to the Service.

Analytics information:

- We use third-party analytics tools to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the Service. These tools collect information sent by your device or our Service, including the web pages you visit, add-ons, and other information that assists us in improving the Service.

Device identifiers:

- When you use a mobile device like a tablet or phone to access our Service, we may access, collect, monitor, store on your device, and/or remotely store one or more "device identifiers." Device identifiers are small data files or similar data structures stored on or associated with your mobile device, which uniquely identify your mobile device. A device identifier may be data stored in connection with the device hardware, data stored in connection with the device's operating system or other software, or data sent to the device.

Metadata:

- Metadata is usually technical data that is associated with User Content. For example, Metadata can describe how, when and by whom a piece of User Content was collected and how that content is formatted.

2. HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

In addition to some of the specific uses of information we describe in this Privacy Policy, we may use information that we receive to:

- help you efficiently access your information after you sign in
- remember information so you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit the Service;
- provide personalised content and information to you and others through emails;
- provide, improve, test, and monitor the effectiveness of our Service
- develop and test new products and features
- monitor metrics such as total number of visitors, traffic, and demographic patterns
- diagnose or fix technology problems

Storage and Processing:

- Your information collected through the Service may be stored and processed in Australia
